Local Jobs for Local Residents

Labour is determined to keep residents across Ordsall in employment. We, your local Labour team, will be sitting down with future employers in our area over the next few weeks and months to offer them our help in ensuring as many local jobs as possible will be made available to the people across the area, from the Ordsall, Stowell and Islington estates all the way to Greengate, St. James' Park and The Quays. Major organisations have already pledged to commit to employing residents of our community.

Jobs on the Ordsall Estate:

- Morrisons are opening a new store on the new District Shopping Centre on Phoebe Street in Sept 2011 and will be creating 280 jobs. We are hoping at least 140 of these jobs will be specifically made available to Ordsall residents.
- Travelodge are opening a new hotel on Trafford Rd and are creating some 50 jobs, they also want to focus their employment efforts on assisting local residents.

Both Morrisons and Travelodge will be working in partnership with Job Centre Plus in the New Year, to help local long-term unemployed people back into work.

Jobs on The Quays:

On the Quays, the BBC will be recruiting over 500 people to work at MediaCityUK in the next year for a whole range of jobs.
